GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Shake original container before use. Periodically agitate suspension during application to ensure thorough mixing.

For best results, form a premix of the required amount of product with an equal volume of water. Stir thoroughly. Add to spray tank and dilute with remaining amount of water. Agitate thoroughly.

Do not store diluted insecticide. Prepare a fresh solution as necessary.

Do not spray the moving parts of any machinery, electric motors or switchgear with the water-based product.

Precautions
