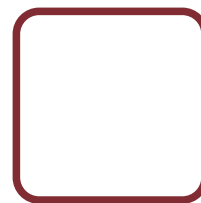

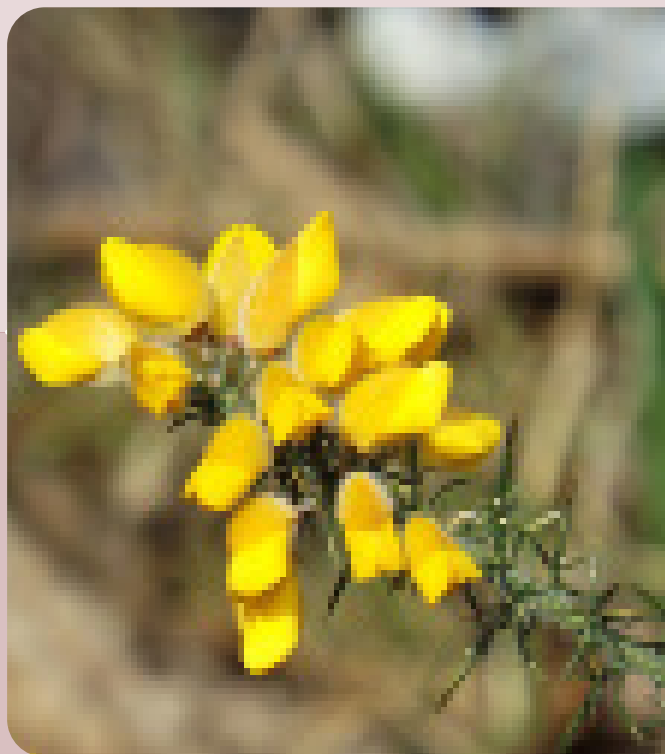


WHY USE PICKER 100

- Imtrade's Picker 100 dual active formulation is a reliable combination with the chemical power to pick out a large number of hardy weeds, including: lantanas, gorse, blackberries/brambles, boxthorns, acacias and eucalypts.
- Registered for use in all states in the country (see label for specific weeds), Imtrade's Picker 100 is a tried and trusted product, specially formulated and manufactured by Imtrade for Australian conditions, saving you the time and effort that would otherwise be required in repeated treatments of weaker chemistry or manual removal.

MODE OF ACTION

- Imtrade's Picker 100 is in the Group I herbicide group and acts by disrupting cell growth. This is a similar process to the phenoxy herbicides. The product is used primarily as a foliar spray although both active ingredients do have some soils persistence depending on the rate of application and rainfall.
- Due to the MOA this product can be slow acting at times, depending on weather conditions and the target weed, but let the active constituents run their course before wasting resources on additional treatments/ Recropping intervals should be observed at all times, though particularly during dry conditions that do not favour the breakdown of the product.



USING PICKER 100

- Read the Label Always read the label when considering Imtrade Picker 100 as your method of removing woody & hard to kill weeds.
- Recropping intervals need to be monitored and are based on normal rainfall patterns. Drier or drought conditions will increase the plantback period. See the complete table in the IMTRADE PICKER 100 label.

TANK MIXING

- Imtrade Picker 100 is compatible with a range of herbicides and adjuvants to enable one pass weed control, making quick and easy work of usually challenging to control weeds.
- Please still DO read the label and compatibility charts before tank mixing Imtrade Picker 100 with other chemistries to ensure chemical compatibility.
- Please also DO a jar test to check physical compatibility – note that this WILL NOT demonstrate chemical compatibility.
- Some common herbicides Picker 100 is compatible with are: 2,4-D Amine, Mestulfuron Methyl, Glyphosate, and Fluroxypyr, among a number of others.
