Lychee	5 Tablets* per 100L water (50ppm)	Apply when majority of the fruit is over 15-20mm in length. Apply once only per season with a suitable sprayer. Use a non-ionic wetter. The results may vary significantly for different varieties of Lychee, season and growing region, depending on the level of natural fruit drop.

Application
